Information we collect

If you require Up-Stage Theatre to contact you, you will be asked to provide your full name, postcode, child age, telephone number, email and (where applicable) mailing address. When you complete the contact form you are giving Up-Stage Theatre permission to contact you by mail (where applicable), email and / or telephone about their services for a period of 90 days from the date of your initial enquiry.

Data Protection and Access rights

You have the right to access the personal data that is held about you by Up-Stage Theatre and request that the information be added to, modified or deleted. You have the right to ask Up-Stage Theatre to stop communicating with you or alter the frequency and manner in which communications are made. Cookies

A cookie is a small text file containing a unique identifier which our websites place on the hard drive of your computer.
